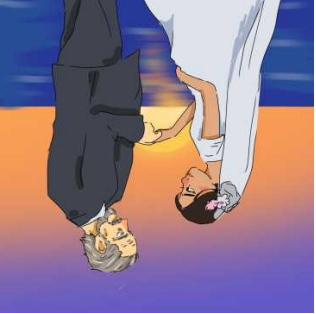

I want to resist, but I do not know how. It is not as easy to live in a foreign country with an old man as a husband as I thought it would be.
