...

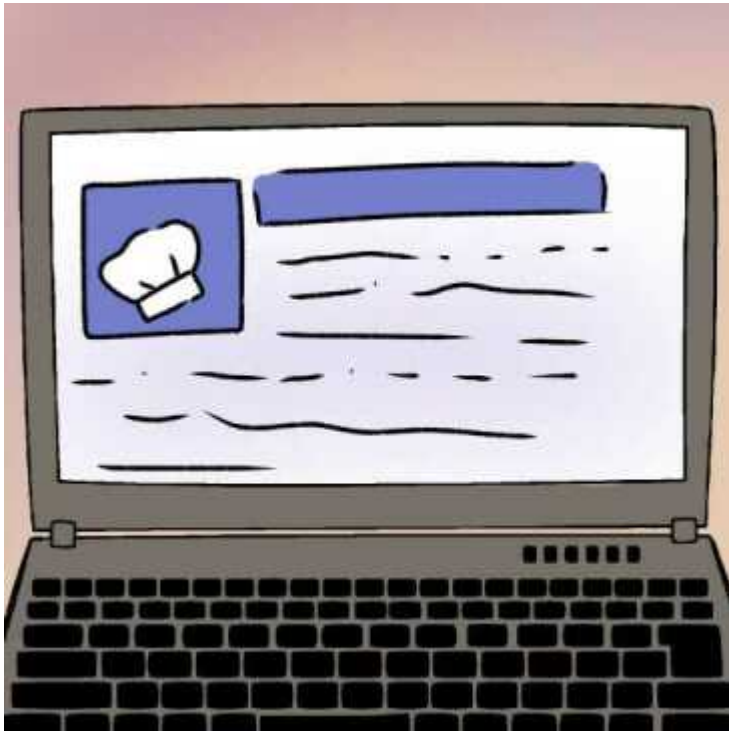
Alisha did not work in her home country, but she is good at cooking and likes talking to people.
