...

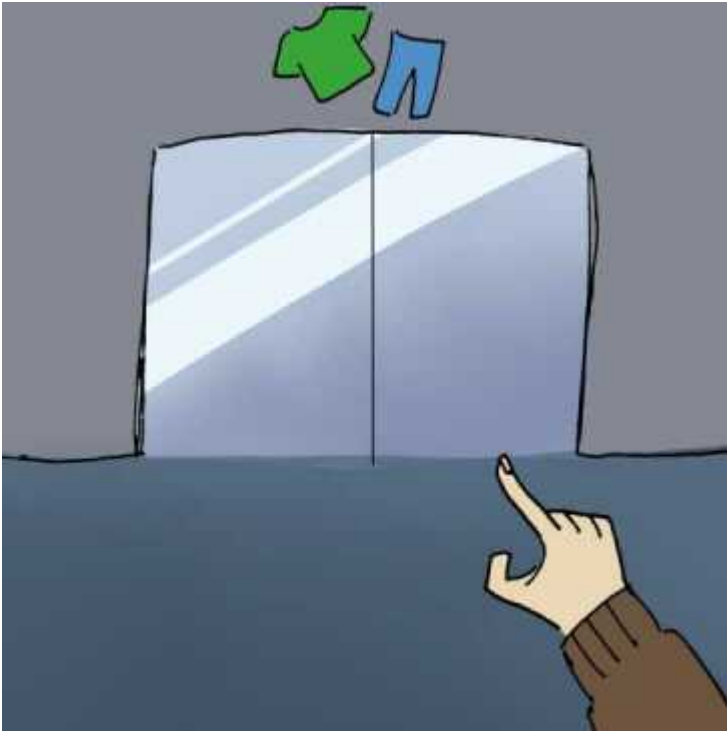
In the shopping mall he cannot find the clothing store.
