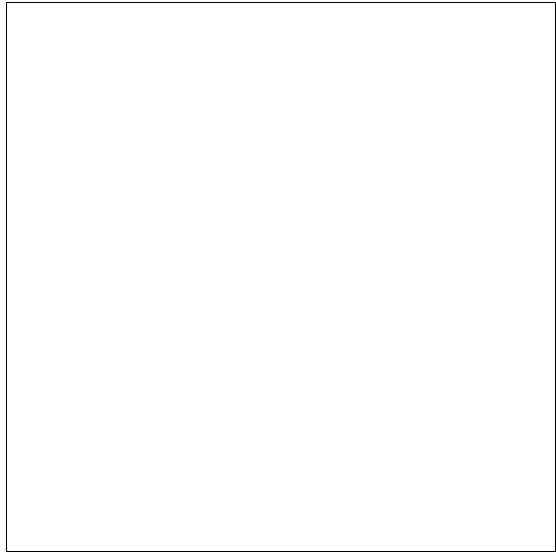
“I also have two daughters, but I’m divorced.”

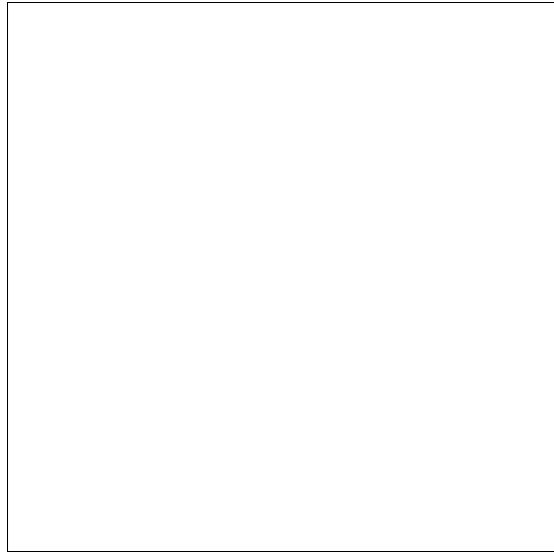
