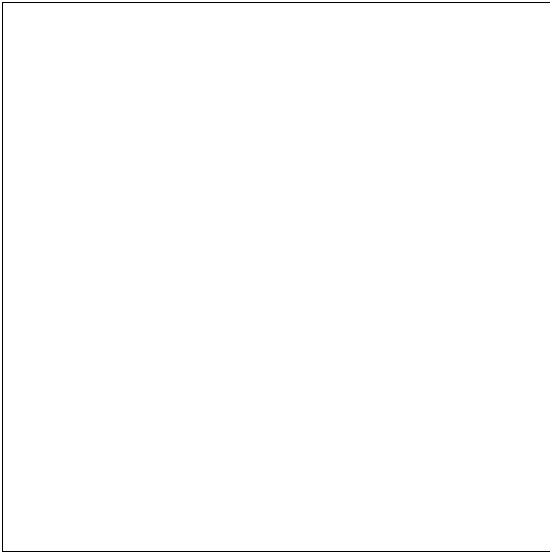
"Sì, mio marito ed io abbiamo due figlie e un figlio."

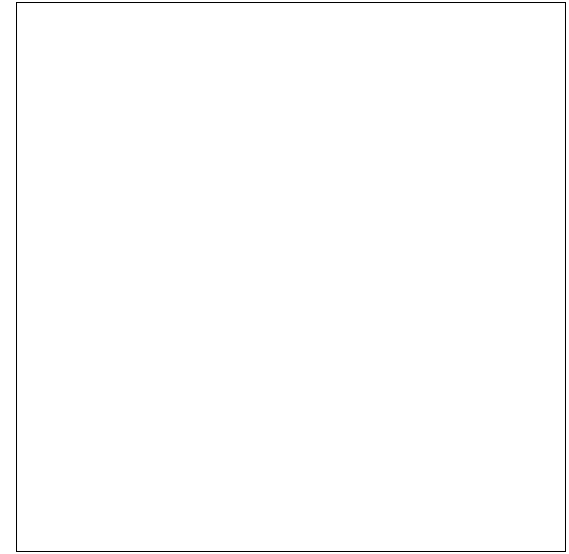
"È una buona idea. Anch'io spero che i miei figli vadano all'università un giorno."

"He wants to get a job, but I tell him he should go to university instead."

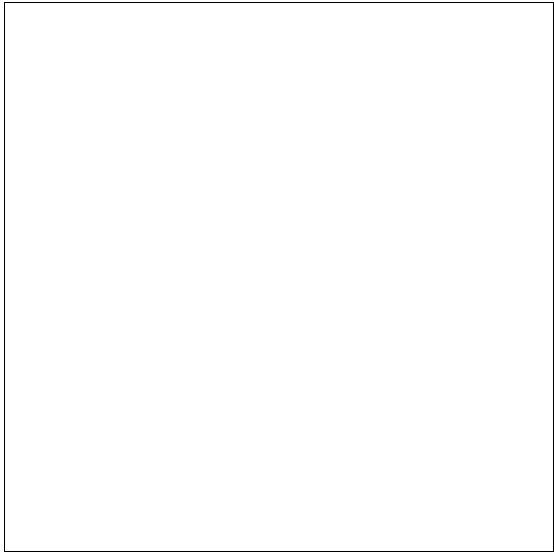
