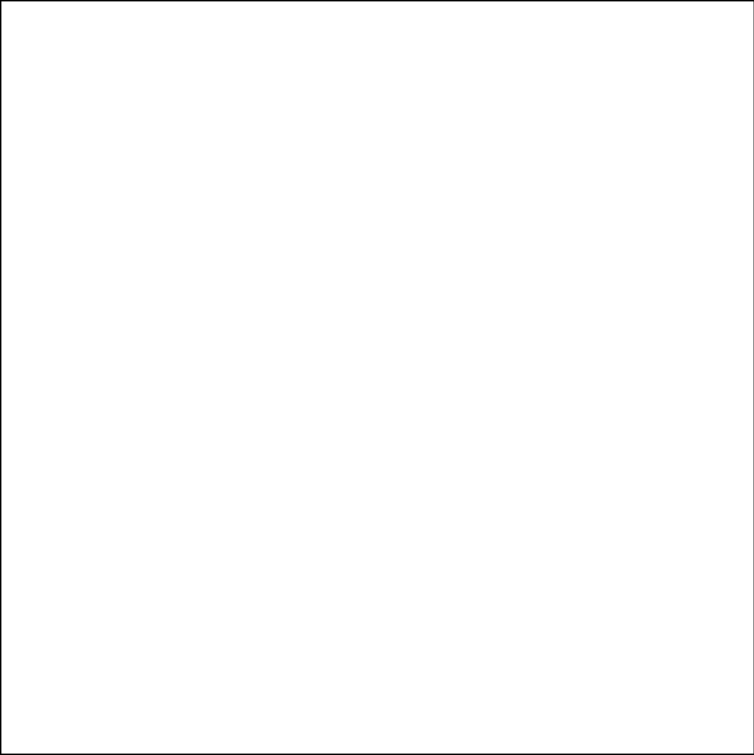

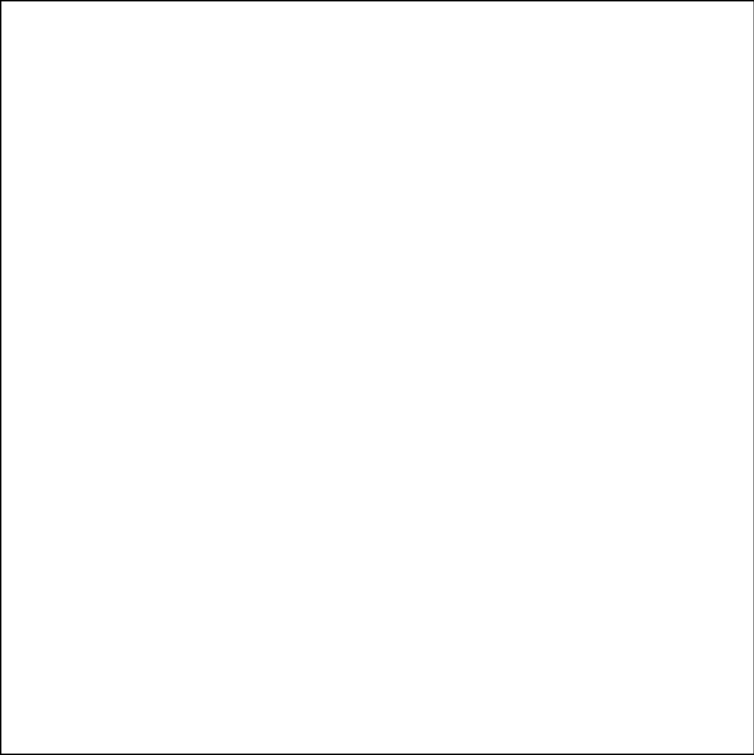
“The days are starting to get cold. What is the temperature?”
