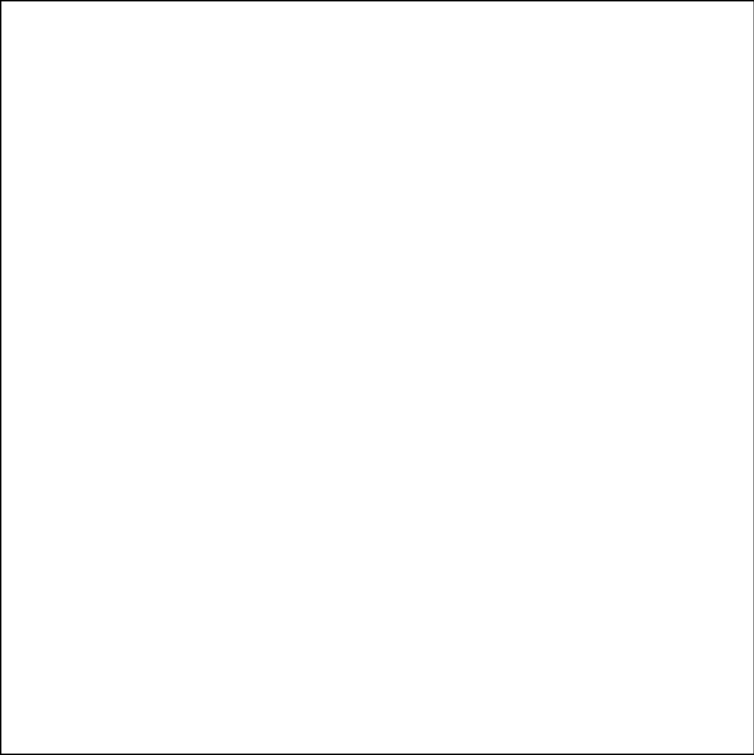
“I don’t mind the cold. It’s the rain and wind I don’t like.”
